

Pepperdine University Site Specifications Overview (Splash Pages)

The following wires are based on a modified 12-column grid system where each column of the grid is 60 pixels wide and the total page width is 960 pixels.

Content areas for Pepperdine's Websites are utilizing a 3-column

structure. Each column will maintain a 300 pixel width.

Each column has 15 pixels of margin on left and right hand side, creating 30 pixel wide gutters between columns.

Vertical distance should reflect this 30 pixel spacial relationship.

1) Consideration of a utility bar to be 30px in height and extend left and right. Content initially will include current items on existing

2) Primary branding of header graphic to be within the live area of 960 px, but will be designed to extend both left and right.

3) Main navigation items to be 30 pixels in height for consistency, ease of use and readability. Navigation width does not need to conform it's dimensions to the 12 column grid system but rather accommodate content needs. Main navigation to be no more than _#_ areas for the user.

4) Main page identifier. Confirms to user most recent selection and a reminder of current content while navigating where to next.

5) Contact information and Social Media connect. * Best location and navigation need to be further explored by ux, design and web dev teams to determine best use scenarios.

6) Slide show to run full width of 960 px grid. Currently displayed on wires at left as 960 x 480. Mobile viewing should be primary consideration for slide shows, therefore there is to be very limited text headline descriptors. Slide show duration should be consistent. There is to be no pagination indicators on slide shows, only left and right hand navigation.

7) Main Content Items maintain a 300 pixel width. Currently displayed on wires at left as 300 x 120.

Content is to be reduced to the essence and placed within appropriate information categories for ease of navigation for the user. Recommend using variable of 3 when possible and suggest 3 or 6 items, but no more than 9 areas of information are to be used. In the rare instance that content is not in a variable of 3 or 6, the additional written bullet point or text information can slide up into the negative space or remain.

8) Additional written bullet point or text information can be used where and when needed for dynamic (most current) items. Use of header followed by ordered/unordered list or copy (text) items may link to further details on pages within or outside of site.

9) Footer details. Footer to attach to base of window, and maintain a minimum window dimension.

10) Main navigation and drop down menus to be simplified into primary content categories.

Mega navigation consideration.





Content areas for Pepperdine's Websites are utilizing the same 3-column structure as splash pages. Each primary column will maintain a 300 pixel width.

1) The left hand navigation items are 300 x 60.

2) The two column (right-hand) format is to maintain a 630 pixel width. Which includes two columns and one gutter.

3) Medium promotional item to be 300 x 240

4) Small promotional item to be 300 x 120

5) Full column width 960


6) One column width 300

7) Two column width 630


8) 3 One column widths; each at 300px and a 30px gutter.

3.0) Headers 1-5 defined by design team including colors, sizes, fonts. Link text including indication of hover, active and live states.

4.0) Standard full column width measuring 630px.







